


Figure 6. Typical Capacitance




Figure 7. Typical Gate Charge




Figure 8. Switching Loss vs. Temperature




Figure 11. Switching Time vs. I_C




Figure 16. Safe Operating Area


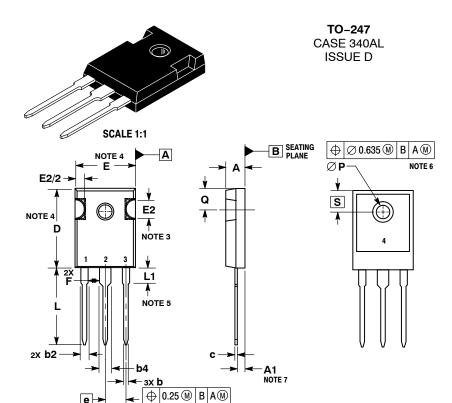


Figure 18. IGBT Transient Thermal Impedance

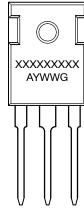
