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






Figure 2. Reverse Characteristics






Figure 5. Capacitive Charge vs. Reverse Voltage






Figure 7. Capacitance Stored Energy

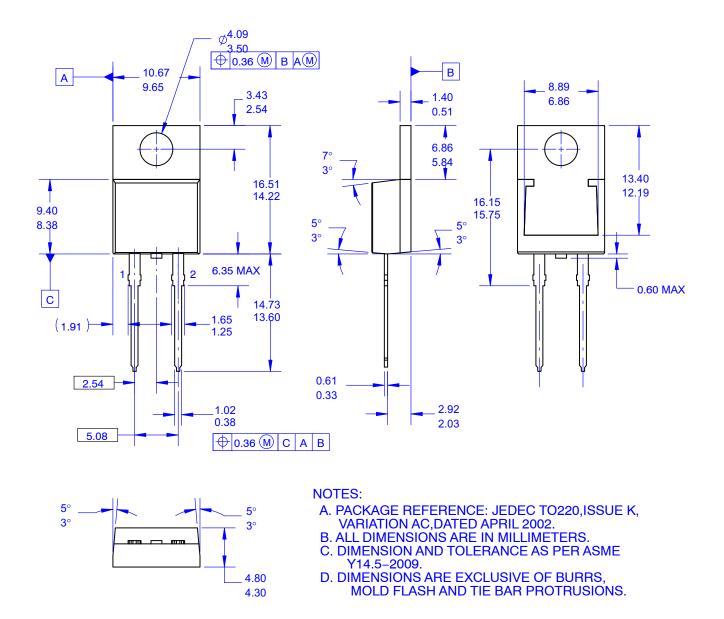
