


Transconductance On-Resistance vs. Drain Current











On-Resistance vs. Junction Temperature




Source Drain Diode Forward Voltage



On-Resistance vs. Gate-to-Source Voltage




Threshold Voltage



Drain Source Breakdown vs. Junction Temperature


